Recommendation 1:

Move mid-level to October/November, all else stays the same (keep CHO social connected to this)
Focus the marketing, streamline the process for program proposals and registration.
Pro dev committee work with other NEACUHO committee chairs to get program proposals in a variety of topics (social issues, program committee, legal issues etc.)
Reach out to presenters earlier for specialized topics as well.

Recommendation 2:

Social issues committee - look at the possibility of moving the three days to one day that share resources on one campus on one day but keep the intent and integrity of the individual retreats for 2010.
This is more cost effective to the organization and our members. This helps with campus resources, carpooling, food, and people not giving up three days of training and give membership time to come together.
